Program Overview

Program Components

Participation in CLS requires a serious commitment of your time, energy and community involvement.

ORIENTATION MEET AND GREET

Meet your fellow classmates and learn about the program's objectives and community issues. This half-day session is the program kick-off and held in October of the year prior to each class.

CLS runs in even numbered years. Application submission is January 15 through June 1 in the year prior to the class with selections and notification in July of that year.
